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

Choose an experienced & skilled builder.

WHEN DESIGNING YOUR RENOVATION, CONSIDER HOW YOUR HOME WILL NEED TO EVOLVE OVER THE COMING YEARS.

Future proofing could mean incorporating a playroom that's later converted to a study, rumpus room or spare; accessibility features like ramps and wider hallways; or home automation technology that simplifies everyday living.

Planning ahead will result in a home that supports your lifestyle for many years to come. Be sure to meet with your architect and builder early in the design stage to workshop ideas and ensure your home meets your needs – now and into the future.

Understand any limitations & **regulations**.

EVERY BUILDING PROJECT IS GOVERNED BY LOCAL BUILDING REGULATIONS.

To ensure your architectural renovation is up to code, you will need to submit applications for a building permit and development approval before construction can begin. To ensure your project remains on schedule, we recommend organising as many of these applications as you can in the early stages of design. This will likely include having land surveys, detailed drawings and engineering reports completed.

Upon completion, these documents may reveal limitations in your design, particularly if your block includes slopes or mandated access passageways. Should this be the case, your building team will be able to come up with alternate design ideas that still allow you to achieve your goals within the regulations.

Identify features you want to keep...

There's nothing better than a seamless transition between the original elements of your home and your newly renovated space. If there are features of your existing design that you don't want to part with – perhaps a striking leadlight or the original exposed timber beams –consider integrating these aspects in your new design. Regardless of the style of your home, a good builder and architect will be able to create synergy between old and new.

...AND KEY AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

A high-quality architectural home works with you, not against you. Approach your renovation with function at the forefront of your mind and take time to consider what's working and, more importantly, what's not working in your existing home.

Maximise the experience of your architect and builder and organise a meeting to discuss potential ideas and savvy design features for your home that will support and enhance everyday living. For big families, this might mean a generous kitchen bench space where the kids can complete homework while the adults prepare dinner. For remote workers, it might mean incorporating a large, light-filled office that encourages productivity.


We find that the most successful renovations draw on an open-plan design, with an emphasis on large windows that maximise natural light and access to fresh air.
